

Luke 21: vs. 1-24

1) Did it surprise you to see Jesus pay such close attention to what people gave in the offering? Explain your answer, why did it or why not.

2) Money is used as a tool to measure value. What is God measuring when He uses this tool?

(self reflection)
3) If Jesus were to observe you giving in the offering, what would be His assessment of you?

4) Read Luke 17: 22-25 How does this passage coupled with His warning in verse 8 (Luke 21) help us understand His return?

5) In verse 9 Jesus says “Do not be terrified, these things must come to pass...”. He is speaking to our worries toward the chaos unfolding around us. Does this help calm your fears about what’s happening? Why or Why not?

6) Read verses 10-12. Do you recognize a similar pattern between what lead up to AD 70 and today?

What are some specific events that make you say yes to the prior question?

7) When reading verses 20-24, do you get the sense that the destruction taking place is random or is it God’s divine penalty for rejecting the messiah?

8) If its God’s penalty then what does that say about our society that we are now seeing similar signs of chaos unfolding?
