3. Aside from their clothing, which looked like lightening, what was said by the messengers that caught the women's attention?
4. How does their message challenge us today concerning our belief in Jesus as the Christ?
5. What was the dilemma in the women discovering the tomb first?
6. There are rumors swirling around Jerusalem about the theft of Jesus' body. What evidence dispels this rumor? (name at least three)

Read Luke 24: 13-35

7. How do these two disciples describe the events of this last week (Passion Week)?
Who do they blame?

8. What caused their spiritual blindness?

Read Luke 24: 25-27 and then re-read Luke 16: 29 & 30

9. What parallels are made by this stranger's (Jesus) remarks here concerning why
God would keep Jesus' identity hidden from them?

10. With regard to the last question, do you personally recognize a time when God or
what He was doing was hidden from you during your faith walk?

11. What are some things we can do to sure up our faith so the actions of God are
not hidden from us?
